District Chair

The district chair must be an elected delegate. This position is viewed as a leadership development opportunity. A delegate holding this position will be paid a \$500 honorarium by Grain Farmers of Ontario. Honorariums are to be claimed via expense form in December.

Key responsibilities

- Acts as a primary point of contact for all delegates and alternates and farmermembers within the district.
- Schedules a meeting of the district delegates and alternates four (4) times per year.
- Holds delegates and alternates accountable for attending meetings
- Presides at delegate meetings and the January District Meeting
- Creates a purposeful meeting agenda in collaboration with the district director
- Along with the director, sets goals and objectives for the district and ensures they
 are met
- Ensures alternates are appointed to take the role of voting delegate at provincial meetings as required
